The Pro Golf Tour is going to be a guest in Egypt, Morocco, Austria, Germany, Czech Republic, Poland and the Netherlands this year.

21 tournaments

There are 21 competitions in total at first-class golf courses on the tour calendar between January and September.

156 players

Up to 156 players from 25 different nations are appearing at the competitions.

660.000 euro prize money

At 19 tournaments a prize money of 30,000 euro is distributed, the Leipziger Golf Open offers 40,000 euro. The season finale Castanea Resort Championship is traditionally endowed with 50,000 euro.

The Top 5 in the Order of Merit for the year qualify for the European Challenge Tour 2018.



The Pro Golf Tour is taking place for the 22nd time in 2018. It is considered to be a superb springboard for a tour player's career. Young talented professionals from all over Europe compete at 21 season tournaments.

As an official satellite tour, Pro Golf Tour provides an opportunity to instantly qualify for the European Challenge Tour. That means: anyone who occupies one of the top 5 rankings in the Pro Golf Tour Order of Merit at the end of the season is promoted and can play in the Challenge Tour the following year. The professional tournament series' results also count for the world golf ranking.

As the leading operator of the tour, PGA of Germany is placing itself in a high-profile position on the stage of tournament golf in Europe.

"Golf Stars of Tomorrow" is the official tour slogan, as young, ambitious talented tee off here who have made it their goal to be the golf stars of tomorrow. The Pro Golf Tour's trademarks are excellent courses, flawless organisation and high-calibre sport. Up to 156 players from roughly 25 different nations compete at the tournaments. The tour is based in Munich at the offices of the main shareholder, PGA of Germany. A team of staff is employed at the tournaments: a tournament director, referees, a starter and a tour assistant, together with those responsible at the host club and indispensable voluntary helpers. They all ensure the professional preparation and implementation of all events.

II lt was my goal to finish in the Top 5 to reach the Challenge Tour

2018. The season developed really positively for me since I've been working with my cousin Matthew Parker as my coach. I'm looking forward to the Challenge Tour and I do feel well prepared."

Congratulations on winning the Pro Golf Tour 2017 overall and being directly promoted to the Challenge Tour, Nicolai von Dellingshausen. When you look back on this fantastic season, to what extent is the Pro Golf Tour suitable for starting a tour player's career?


The Pro Golf Tour is ideal as a spring-board to start your career in so far as you find a well-filled but not an overloaded tournament calendar. As a result there is enough time between the tournaments for your own training and to process the experiences you've had. The competition has also increased greatly on the tour continuously over the last few years and the best Pro Golf Tour players are generally also more than capable of competing on higher-ranking tours.

What other experiences that you had on the Pro Golf of the year he also Tour will help you progress further? won the overall

The first time it's basically about earning a living with the sport. Playing for tangible amounts first of all makes acclimatisation a bit easier. Another aspect is definitely getting used to a lot of travelling and planning it ideally.

What's your advice for players who also want to get into professional golf through the Pro Golf Tour?

I would advise every player to be patient and work hard. I also think it's essential to see the profession as a job without losing your enjoyment of it. You have to invest all your energy in your own training for the Pro Golf Tour to be what it's intended for: a springboard and not a final destination.



Nicolai von Dellingshausen celebrated three wins on the Pro Golf Tour in 2017 and was therefore immediately promoted to the Challenge Tour during the current season. At the end of the year he also won the overall ranking in the Pro Golf Tour Order of Merit 2017.

The path to the Pro Golf Tour

The Pro Golf Tour is one of four official satellite tours alongside the PGA EuroPro Tour, the Alps Tour and the Nordic League. The Top 5 in the year's final ranking are authorised to tee off on the European Challenge Tour the following season. The top players are also exempt from Stage I of the European Tour Qualifying School.

"The Pro Golf Tour is very similar to the main tours!"

Florian, how do you rate the Pro Golf Tour as a springboard into professional golf?

The Pro Golf Tour is an important stop for every aspiring young pro. As the tournaments don't just take place in Central Europe but in North Africa too, they don't just include sporting elements but also organisational factors. The players have to learn how to organise and manage themselves. These are two very important areas. The playing standard is also very sound. There are enough good players to produce a sporting atmosphere.

Is it an all-round successful tour for young talent?

For what the Pro Golf Tour wants to be: yes! You move around a great deal, can play full season and also have to cope outside Europe. The prize money breakdown is also similar to the main tournaments so that you are forced to play well and hold your own over a longer period of time.

Has the tour helped you in your personal sporting career?

Yes. In my opinion it is important to learn to play a full season, to hold your own and also cope with fluctuations in performance. In comparison to this, for example, the European Tour Qualifying School shows time and time again that one good week in a year does not qualify a player to play consistently on the next level of tour. To learn this you have to give yourself the time to mature by

playing in lots of tournaments. That is exactly what the Pro Golf Tour offers.

What are your fondest memories with regard to your time on the Pro Golf Tour?

The camaraderie. We were all pretty broke and even the top five cannot actually finance a season with the prize money won. In this respect you have to find ways to keep costs down. This leads to you all pulling together and helping each other out. And this results in great and lasting friendships that I would not want to be without.

What, would you say, distinguishes the Pro Golf Tour especially?

I think the tour is really successful in trying to prepare young players for the next level of tours. From the prize money breakdown to the ranking and regular processes, the tour is very similar to the Challenge Tour and European Tour. That's the biggest sporting advantage of the Pro Golf Tour.

What do you advise young players just starting their career on the Pro Golf Tour?

Patience is important and a good team around you. And you should take the tour as what it is: a development tour to achieve great things later on.



SEASON 2018



Match play premiere and great golf

There are 21 tournaments in total in seven different countries on the Pro Golf Tour calendar in the 2018 season. Prize money of 660,000 euros is being distributed and just as many points for the Pro Golf Tour Order of Merit, the official tour ranking, are being issued in the process. For the first time the professionals will decide one of the tournament winners in a match play format.

An early start to the tour on excellent courses in the sunny South, return to Central Europe to tried and tested venues at the end of April and top-class newcomers: The Pro Golf Tour 2018 season promises plenty of sporting highlights.

The tournament year starts with two events by the Red Sea in Egypt, followed by seven tournaments in Morocco. The tour has been fostering a close partnership with the Association du Trophée Hassan II de Golf since 2010. Austria is represented on the tournament calendar three times this year, the players are travelling to the Czech Republic and to Poland. At the Broekpolder International Open the tour returns to the Netherlands: from 5 to 7 July players compete for another EUR 30,000 prize money in Vlaardingen. Six tournaments in total are scheduled in Germany this summer, the newcomers here are the Leipziger Golf Open 2018 (6 to 8 August) at the Golf & Country Club Leipzig with EUR 40,000 prize money and the NEW GOLF CLUB Match Play Championship 2018 that is being held at New Golf Club Neu-Ulm from 2 to 5 September and, as the name already reveals, is being organised in a match play format. The battle is then on for EUR 50,000 prize money and the awarding of the promotion tickets to the Challenge Tour 2019 at the grand tour finale, the Castanea Resort Championship 2018.

The venues for all the Pro Golf Tour 2018 order of merit tournaments and the qualifying school for the 2019 season at GC Paderborner Land are on pages 20 and 21 of this brochure.

"Everyone enjoyed this tournament!"

What did you and your members think of the Pro Golf Tour tournament last summer?

It was fantastic to be able to organise a high-ranking tournament again after 30 years. Normally, closed courses for tournaments are not endorsed by our members but this was

different this time. Everyone enjoyed the energy and great mood that the upcoming professionals brought to our golf club. The interest in excellent quality golf was huge, which was also confirmed by the many spectators, especially during the final round. It was of course a special highlight for our youngsters to practice together with for example Nicolai von Dellingshausen and our local hero Clemens Prader.

Did you receive feedback after the tournament?

The feedback was 100 percent positive. Golfers from our neighbouring clubs were also on site and accompanied the Pro Golf Tour players on the round. There was wide coverage in the local media, e.g. the Salzburger Nachrichten. We were particularly delighted by a two-minute report in ORF sport at prime time. Two days later there was also a 30-minute report on ORF Sport+.

Did your club also attract attention from external (green fee) players due to the tournament?

I was at tournaments in Germany several times last summer and was spoken to time and time again: "You were hosting the Pro Golf Tour!"

What awaits players this year?

When we host the tour this year from 19th to 21st July the tournament is going to take place on our championship course "Schmittenhöhe".



The German Marcel Schneider was promoted to the Challenge Tour as the winner of the Pro Golf Tour Order of Merit in 2014. He secured the right to play the European Tour in the 2018 season in the final stage of the European Tour Qualifying School in 2017, as did the former Order of Merit runner-up Sebastian Heisele.



I When I went with my Mother for careers advice in Augsburg in 1972, I'd just turned 15, and said that I wanted to be a golf professional, the documents there were checked with the outcome: this profession doesn't exist! The profession did exist but much of what is available today that young tour players benefit from didn't actually exist back then. First and foremost, there wasn't a competition level back then where I would have been able to test out whether I was good enough to be able to live from golf. The only tour was the European Tour and to be able to play there at all as a rookie meant coming at least second in the Monday aualifiers. Starting a tour plauer career in this way was as tough as it was educational but it was ultimately also a huge risk.

Thanks to a tour like the Pro Golf Tour, young players today have an exceptionally good opportunity to put themselves and their own skills to the test. The Pro Golf Tour is a platform for international competition that gives everyone the chance to start their professional career in an uncomplicated way. It leads onto the Challenge Tour for the best and you can manage to get onto the European Tour from there. This fantastic opportunity to gain competition practice, play on challenging golf courses and compete with international opponents is just what young players

need to prepare for life on one of the major tours. And that is exactly what a satellite tour must be: an environment to test out your own playing strength at a high level with little risk. It's not about earning prize money to permanently earn a living on the Pro Golf Tour. It's about acquiring skills that are the basis for a career as a tour player during weekly matches. Providing young talent with these competition opportunities is the aim, in fact the mission of the Pro Golf Tour. And it has been fulfilling this mission in the best conceivable manner for years."

How do you rate the Pro Golf Tour as a springboard into professional golf?

The Pro Golf Tour is the perfect way to transition from amateur to pro. You are immediately playing at a high level, have the comparison with your colleagues and can win prize money by producing good results that at least cover your costs. My time on the Pro Golf Tour was an experience that I would not want to have missed out on.

What do you fondly remember when you think back to your just under half a year on the Tour?

I often think back to that time. I always drove my own car to tournaments, had lots of time to think about what I had to work on and was able to gain my first important experiences as a professional. I will also never forget Bernd Kraft, who is the unique starter of the tour's tournaments since many years. It was a really wonderful time.

The former EPD Tour, todays Pro Golf Tour, was the ideal stepping stone to professional golf for me. The tournaments are organised and delivered very professionally, the courses are extremely well maintained and challenging, and the competition on the tour, which I still follow with interest, is getting stronger and stronger. I don't think there's a better opportunity anywhere in Europe for a young ambitious player to be introduced to professional golf today, gain experience in tournaments and then start on their career path to the European Tour through the Pro Golf Tour."



Is it a successful tour?

In my opinion, yes. For young people in their early 20s who could turn their passion into their job it is the perfect stepping stone into working life and also the world of professional golf. Naturally you have to learn to organise yourself and to prepare yourself but that is something that is very helpful to your further career path as a pro.

Did the tour help you on your way?



Definitely. The courses that you play during the tournaments are usually in top condition but not quite as difficult as those on the Challenge Tour or European Tour. It is therefore a perfect first step as you are not overwhelmed by the difficulty straight away and can gradually get used to a higher level. In addition, you have a direct comparison with quite a few other very good players.

Martin Kaymer from Mettmann/Germany is the most famous former member of the Pro Golf Tour. He won the ranking list in 2006 with five tournament wins, plaued a new German record round of 59 at the Habsberg Classic and qualified in the same year for the European Tour via the Challenge Tour (two wins). He climbed to first place in the world golf ranking on 28th February 2011 and in the meantime also has two Major titles to his name.
